



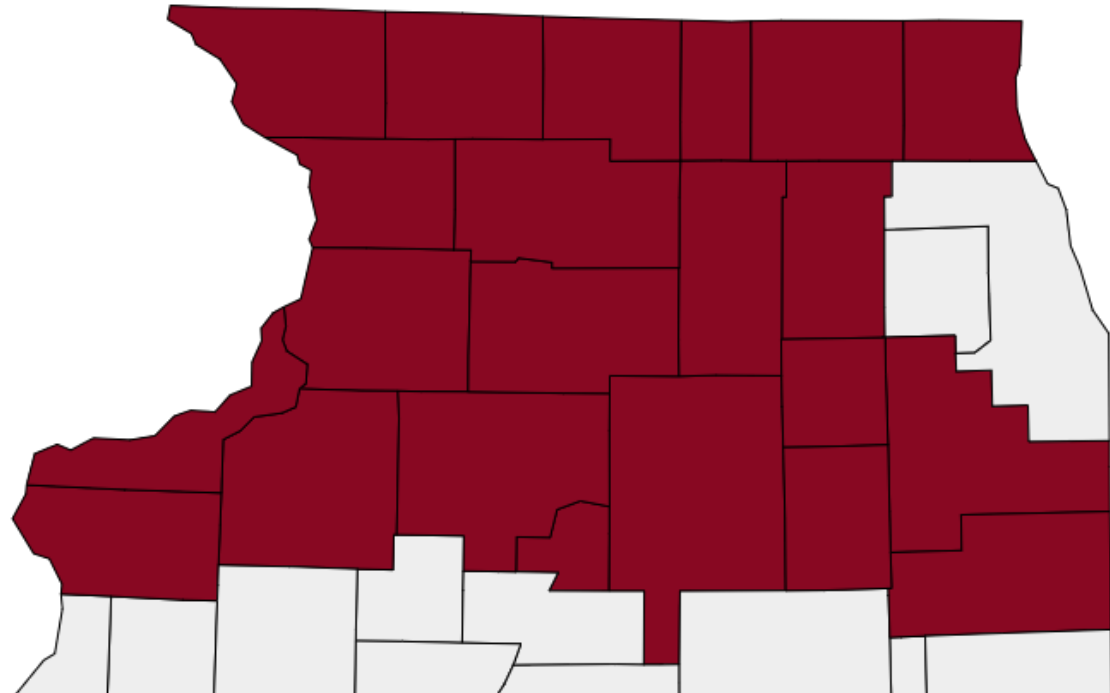

# Circulation Features Available

---

## **Repeated Bills Feature:**

Can send 2 additional bills, each 30 days apart, after replacement bill sent

Text is the same as the current replacement bill

## **3-Day Hold Pickup Feature:**

Intended for special items only that are high turnover, such as hotspots

Allows for items to remain on the holdshelf for only 3 business days, in contrast to the standard 6 business days

To enable either feature for your library, submit a help desk ticket

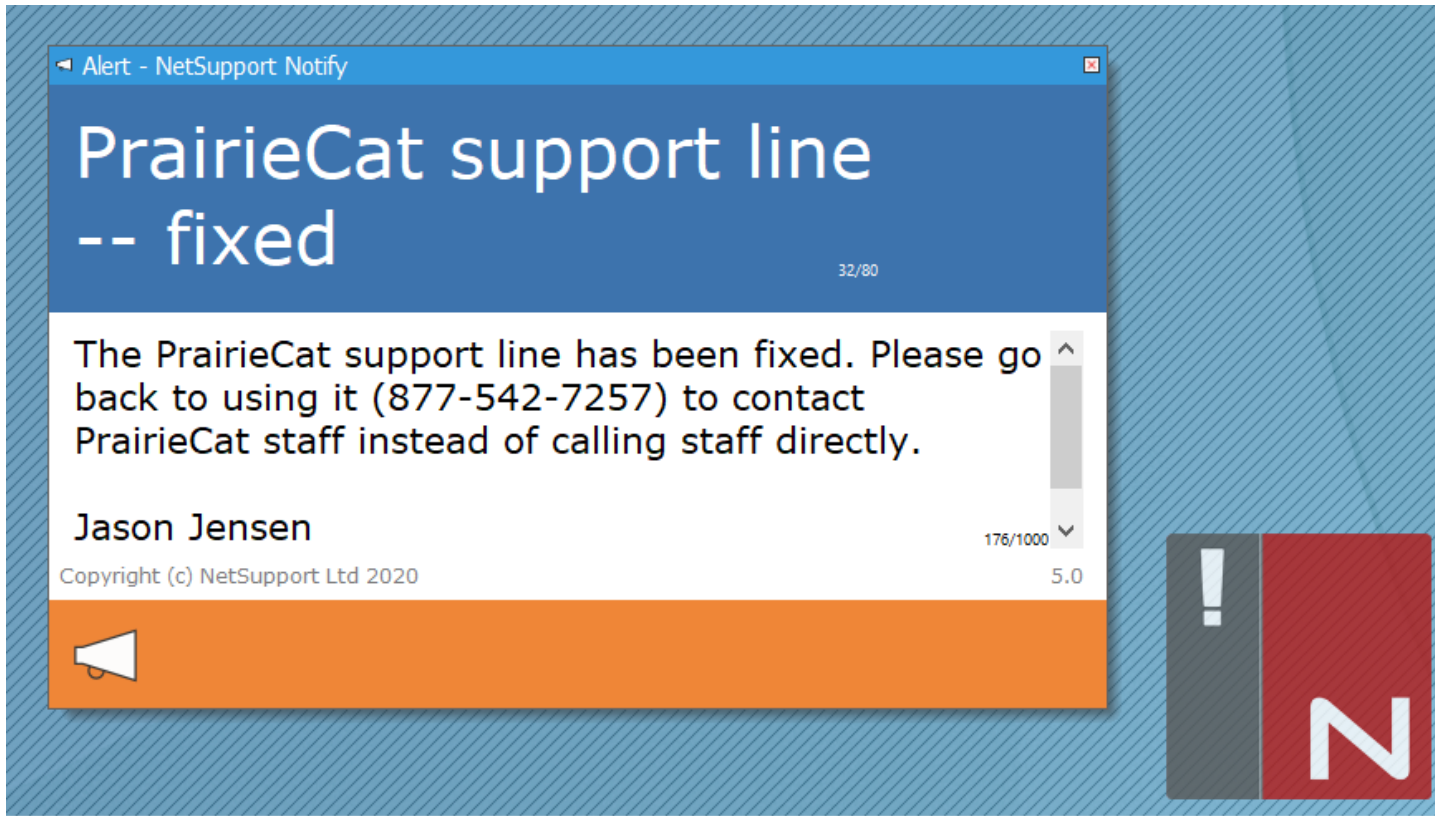

# IMLS Changes and Impacts

## Timeline

- **May 1** - A judge [temporarily blocked](#) the Trump administration from further dismantling of IMLS. [Read the full ruling.](#)
- **April 11** - AISLE, CARLI, IHLS, ILA, and RAILS shared [a joint statement in response to changes at IMLS.](#)
- **April 7** - The American Library Association (ALA), along with the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME), files a lawsuit [asking the court to block the dismantling of the IMLS.](#)
- **April 5** - [Illinois Attorney General Kwame Raoul joins a lawsuit](#) with 21 other states to stop President Trump from defunding IMLS and other federal agencies.
- **April 3** - Several states including California, Connecticut, and Washington, received written notifications from IMLS Acting Director Keith Sonderling that their IMLS grants were cancelled.
- **April 3** - A group of publishers sent a message to Acting Director Keith Sonderling [expressing concern over the turmoil at IMLS.](#)
- **April 3** - Members of the [IMLS Board sent a letter to Keith Sonderling](#), Acting Director of IMLS, asking for clarification about the recent decision to place the staff of IMLS on administrative leave.
- **April 2** - [Members of Congress wrote a letter](#) to express their concern over the proposed elimination of the IMLS.
- **March 31** - [ALA issued a statement](#) reacting to IMLS staff being placed on leave.
- **March 31** - All IMLS staff were placed on administrative leave and all grants and contracts were suspended.
- **March 28** - Illinois Secretary of State Alexi Giannoulias [sent a letter to all Illinois library staff](#) about the impact of IMLS funding cuts.
- **March 26** - A bipartisan group of Senators [sent a letter to Keith Sonderling](#), Acting Director of IMLS. The Senators are the lead authors of the Museum and Library Services Act (MLSA), which was signed into law by President Trump.
- **March 14** - Executive Order signed.

# Summary of IMLS Changes and Impacts

---

Excerpt from April 11, 2025 Joint Statement on Changes at the Institute of Museum and Library Services from Illinois library agencies:

How does all of this affect Illinois? In Illinois, [federal funding to libraries is distributed by the Illinois State Library](#) through the [IMLS Grants to States program](#), with funding totaling \$5.7 million in FY 2024—the sixth-highest amount in the country. This funding supports resources, grants, public library programming, professional development, and operations for various types of libraries, with a focus on underserved areas.

Monies are also allocated to the Illinois Heartland Library System (IHLS) and the Reaching Across Illinois Library System (RAILS) under the System Area & Per Capita Grant Program. This includes funding that facilitates the delivery of books and library materials across Illinois through interlibrary loan services.

# Summary of IMLS Changes and Impacts

---

May 6, 2025 Excerpt from [RAILS News Post](#)

Illinois State Library (ISL) has directed the regional library systems (including RAILS) to submit plans at level funding for the upcoming fiscal year (FY 2026). This means ISL is planning for a FY 2026 financial year that looks a lot like FY 2025.

Congress will need to reauthorize the Museum and Library Services Act for the next federal financial year that funds the IMLS programs, inclusive of the Grants to States program. This means that continuing funding of the IMLS will require further congressional actions.

# Summary of IMLS Changes and Impacts

---

## How is PrairieCat funded?

Member Fees: PrairieCat is funded primarily through membership fees, which covers approximately 70-75% of costs. The Delegates Assembly annually reviews and votes on the PrairieCat budget and members fees.

RAILS Grant: PrairieCat also applies for an annual grant from RAILS to provide services and support to member libraries. The RAILS grant typically covers 25-30% of costs, with the remaining costs covered by membership fees.

## How is RAILS funded?

Most of RAILS funding is provided from the Illinois State Library and the Illinois Secretary of State. However, the Illinois State Library receives roughly 10% of their total budget from the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS).

# Summary of IMLS Changes and Impacts

---

PrairieCat does not anticipate any direct or immediate funding impact from the changes at IMLS. However, we encourage libraries to continue to advocate for this important institution.

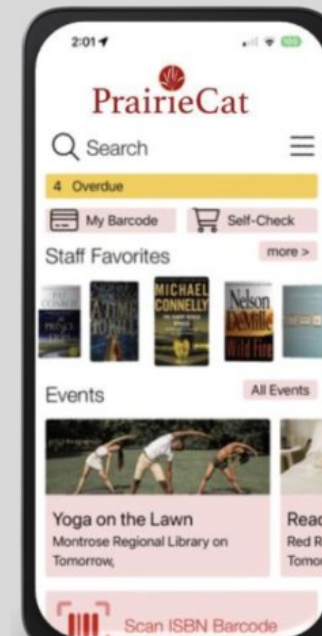
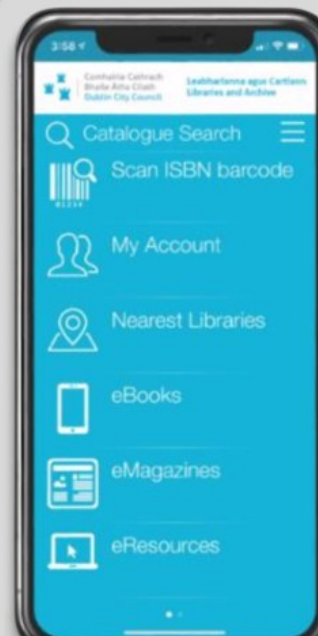
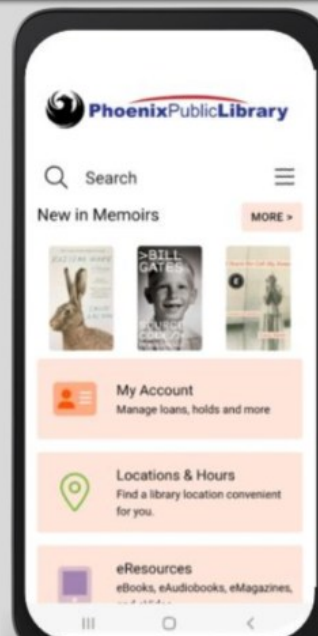
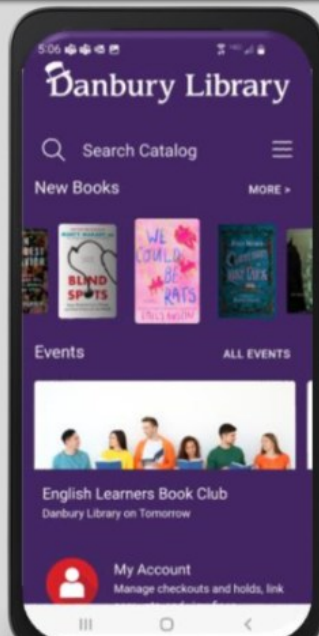
# Innovative Mobile App

# LX Starter | What's Next

---

PrairieCat began working with small group of libraries. After feedback and further review, decided to pause the project.

Outstanding issue that has been reported to Innovative project managers: Staff not being able to access the email suppression list once patron emails bounce. Since notices are generated from the item owning libraries, many of our member libraries could be impacted by this issue, even though they are not participating in the test.
