

Sierra Offline Circulation lets your library keep checking items out during outages or maintenance.

Be ready before you need it!

Don't wait until an outage to set up the Sierra Offline Client.

PrairieCat Systems Update

IP Project: PrairieCat is working on an annual project to verify the IP information that we have from the libraries. Verifying the IP's in use by the member libraries allows us to clean out both our Limit Network Access tables as well as our firewalls allowed access table, allowing us to help prevent unauthorized access to Sierra.

Sierra Upgrade: Upgraded to version 6.4 on 11/19. A few relatively minor changes to the Sierra 6.4 software that affect circulation. These are detailed on the <u>support site</u>.




Verify that NSN is installed on all workstations at your library.



Member Forums







My Account Portal

This may take a few days to take effect.




