Membership Update

- Byron CUSD data has been loaded. PrairieCat staff are working with library staff on training.
- Northern8 project is on schedule. PrairieCat staff will start scheduling trainings in February for library staff.

Correction to reclassification compensation

- There was a slight discrepancy in the memo due to a rounding error. This has been corrected.

Changes to PUG day allowances

- After reviewing the PUG Day fees and allotments, it is more equitable to increase the Tier 1 allotment from 8 library staff to 12. The Council voted to approve this change.

Delegates' Assembly Agenda

- The Council decided to add a Syndetics update and an inventory demo to the agenda.
- The Delegates meetings have all been moved to the dining room since the tiered room was becoming too small.

Talent LMS
