**PrairieCat assists members in the successful sharing of resources and services, expanding the quality and quantity of information accessible to our library users.**



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# Engagement

Members are actively engaged at all levels, which creates connections and advances the organization.

# Training

## Talent LMS Courses

51 self-paced courses

2,950 courses completed | 445 users

- **TalentLMS:** Self-paced courses available 24/7 through PrairieCat's online training platform. The majority of PrairieCat trainings are offered online such as searching, holds, circulation, and cataloging. More advanced classes are offered as live, on-demand classes.
- **Item Entry Certification:** 35 library staff completed Item Entry Certification through TalentLMS. PrairieCat requires that any staff that adds new items to the PrairieCat database are item entry certified to help maintain the accuracy of the database.
- **Create Lists Training:** 22 library staff completed the training through TalentLMS. Create Lists is available to Fully Participating members and the training must be completed to use this Sierra function.



# User Experience

Members are supported in their efforts to provide exceptional service to end users.

- **Innovative Interfaces:** PrairieCat transitioned to the new Vega Discover catalog. This included customization of the 138 individual collection sites including homepages, library branding, and ematerial integration. PrairieCat staff and members participated in beta testing and feedback for several features related to the Vega Suite.
- **Innovative Phone Alerts:** PrairieCat migrated phone dialer services to IPA. This provides patrons with automated phone messages for available holds and first overdue notices.
- **eRead Illinois:** The Delegates Assembly voted to approve eRead Illinois membership for the consortium for 3 years for circulating member libraries.
- **Fine Free Libraries:** 6 PrairieCat libraries went fine free during FY24 bringing the total to 58. PrairieCat staff provided system support and resources to make these changes possible.
- **Mobile App:** 57 PrairieCat libraries have opted in to provide a mobile option for their users.

# Governance

Leadership is transparent, responsive, innovative, and accountable.

- **Delegates Assembly:** 85% voting member attendance rate
- **FY25 Administrative Council and Committees Election:** 58% member participation
- PrairieCat welcomed **19 new directors** at member libraries in FY24.
- **Membership Changes:** Winnebago Public Library joined as a new Fully Participating member. PrairieCat staff worked with Innovative and library staff on the 6-month migration project. Winnebago went live in January 2024. Putnam County Schools, a current Fully Participating member, added the primary school as a new location in January 2024. Mills and Petrie Memorial Library and Gymnasium is upgrading from Union Listing to Basic Online membership level. Oglesby Public Library District downgraded from Fully Participating to Basic Online membership level.
- **Sustainability:** RAILS grant funds accounted for approximately 28% of PrairieCat budgeted revenues in FY24 in addition to in-kind services.
